

## **TESTING PHASE IN BELGIUM**

From May to June, we had the opportunity to test our platform! We organised different sessions and gave the opportunity to our participants to do it the way suited them the best. Some sessions were planified at a certain time in Brussels, others were organised as permanency, some participants did it directly with one of the members or partners of the organisation, others did it at home and received a google form to fill in the evaluation. The sessions were also introduced by a longer or shorter explanation of the project, and more especifically, about the 19 transversal competences.
