After the international training in Turkey (June 2022), each partner had the task to train at least 20 new e-tutors of the Migrantech platform. FaMiDo organised in Belgium **three sessions** and trained **21 new e-tutors**. The aim was to provide tailer-made e-learning tools and methods for professionals working with migrants and refugees, in order to facilitate their socio-professional inclusion;

PROGRAM OF THE DAY

INTRODUCTION

We started with a short presentation of the project: objectives - calendar - results.
We also briefly presented the 4 partners
Before starting the activities, we also made the objectives of the training clear.

PART 1: THE E-TUTOR

What is an e-tutor? What do we expect from an e-tutor? In groups, the participants defined the knowledge, attitude and skills of an etutor. The Migrantech e-tutor Charter was presented

PART 2: THE CONTENT

What does the Migrantech e-tutor need to know? We detailed their knowledge on the modules and tools of the platform.

PART 3: THE ACTION

The participants tested the role of e-tutor in pairs.

CONCLUSION

We had a debriefing on the experience and learning and agreed on the future : how will they use the platform and be e-tutors.

This activity of the project was a one daytraining. Each sessions, e-tutors trained in Turkey or Belgium (for the 2nd and 3rd session) were present to support the learning of the new ones. We had about 12 participants/session. Their mixed background made the interactions very enriching.





THE PARTICIPANTS

The background of the participants was varied. They all shared their experience and knowledge between each other, making each participant more "complete" in their role as e-tutor.

IN THE FUTURE
